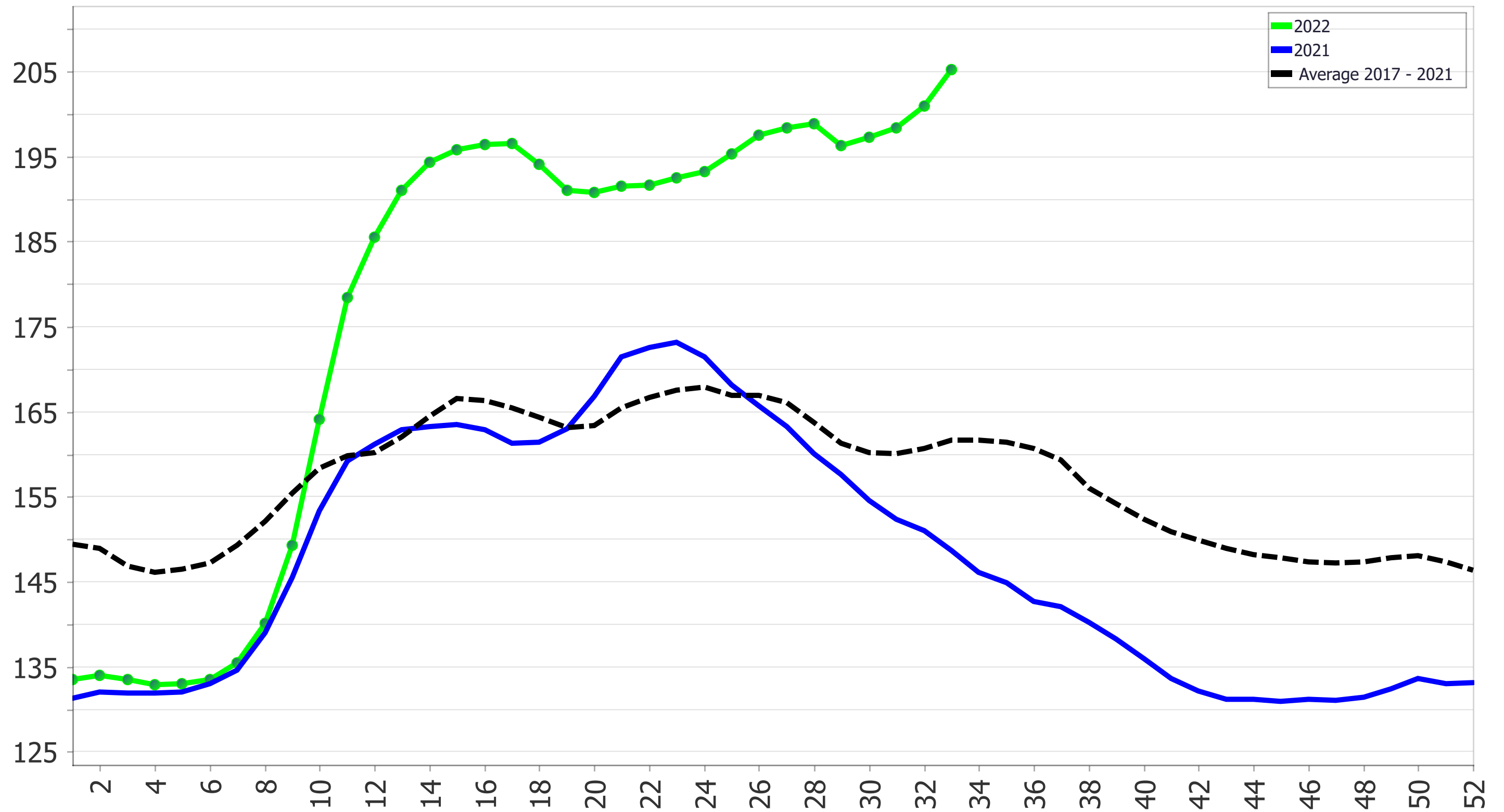

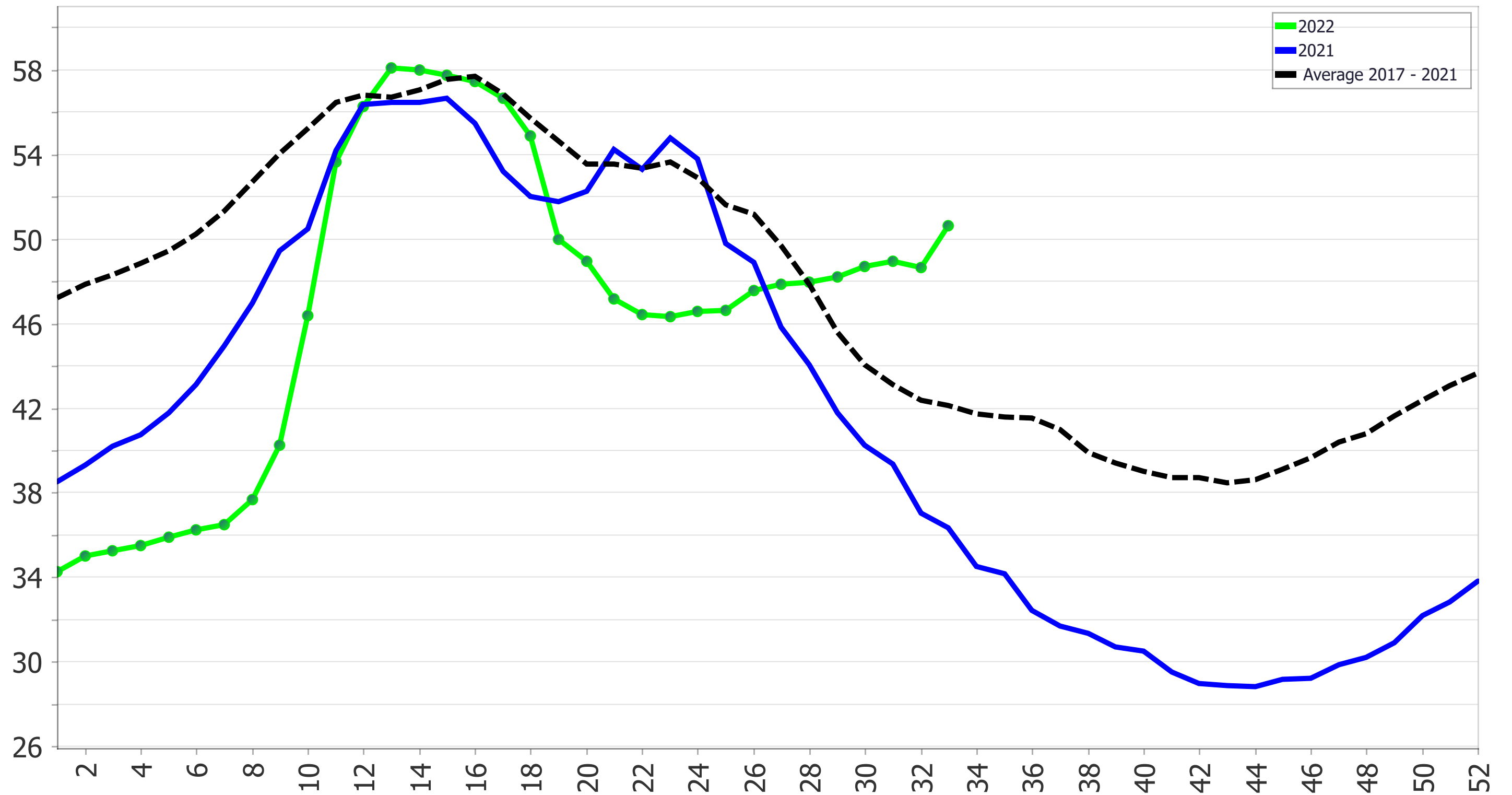
EU evolution of the EU pig carcasse prices (€/100kg)

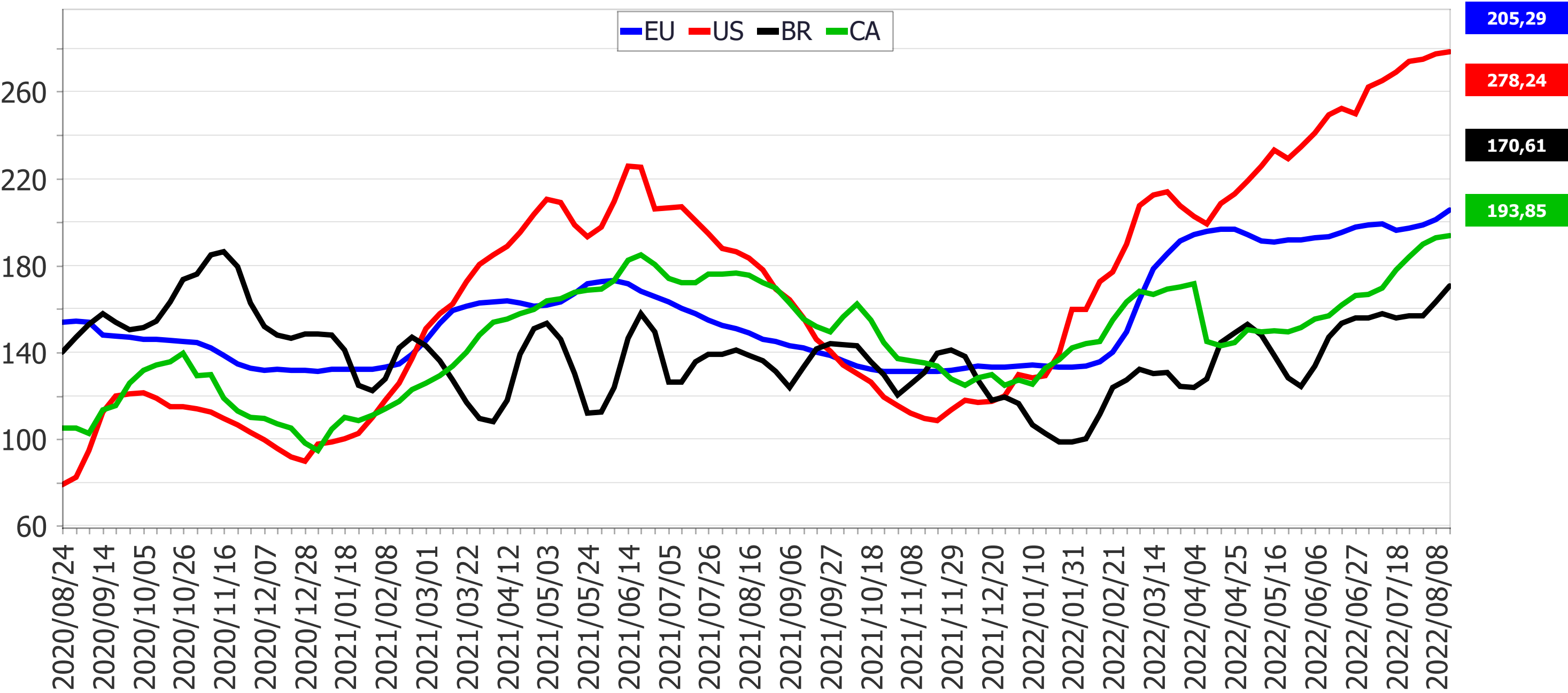
EU evolution of the EU average piglet prices (€/head)

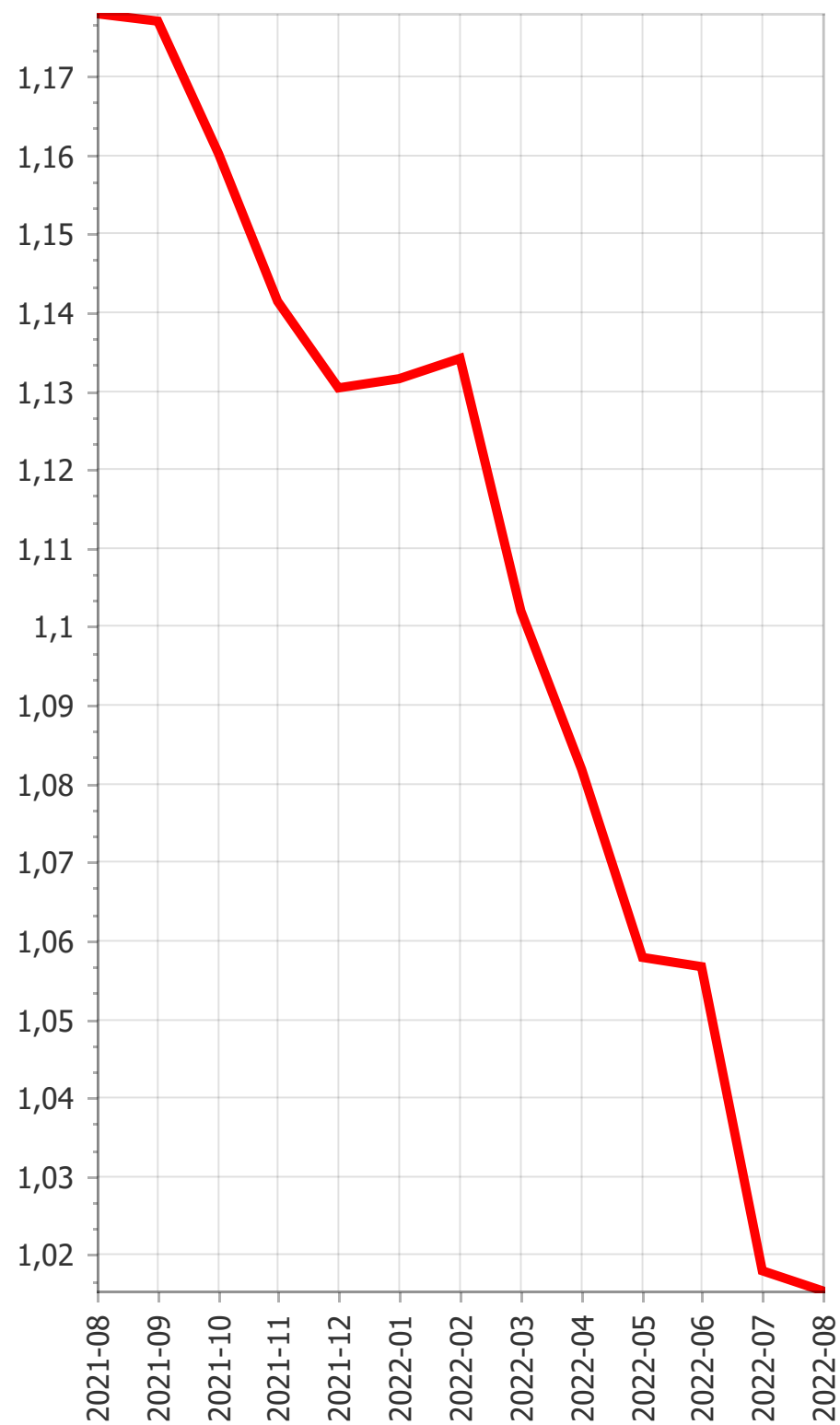

World weekly average Pig Prices 2020-2022 in Euro / 100Kg carcase (EU, Brazil, Canada and USA)

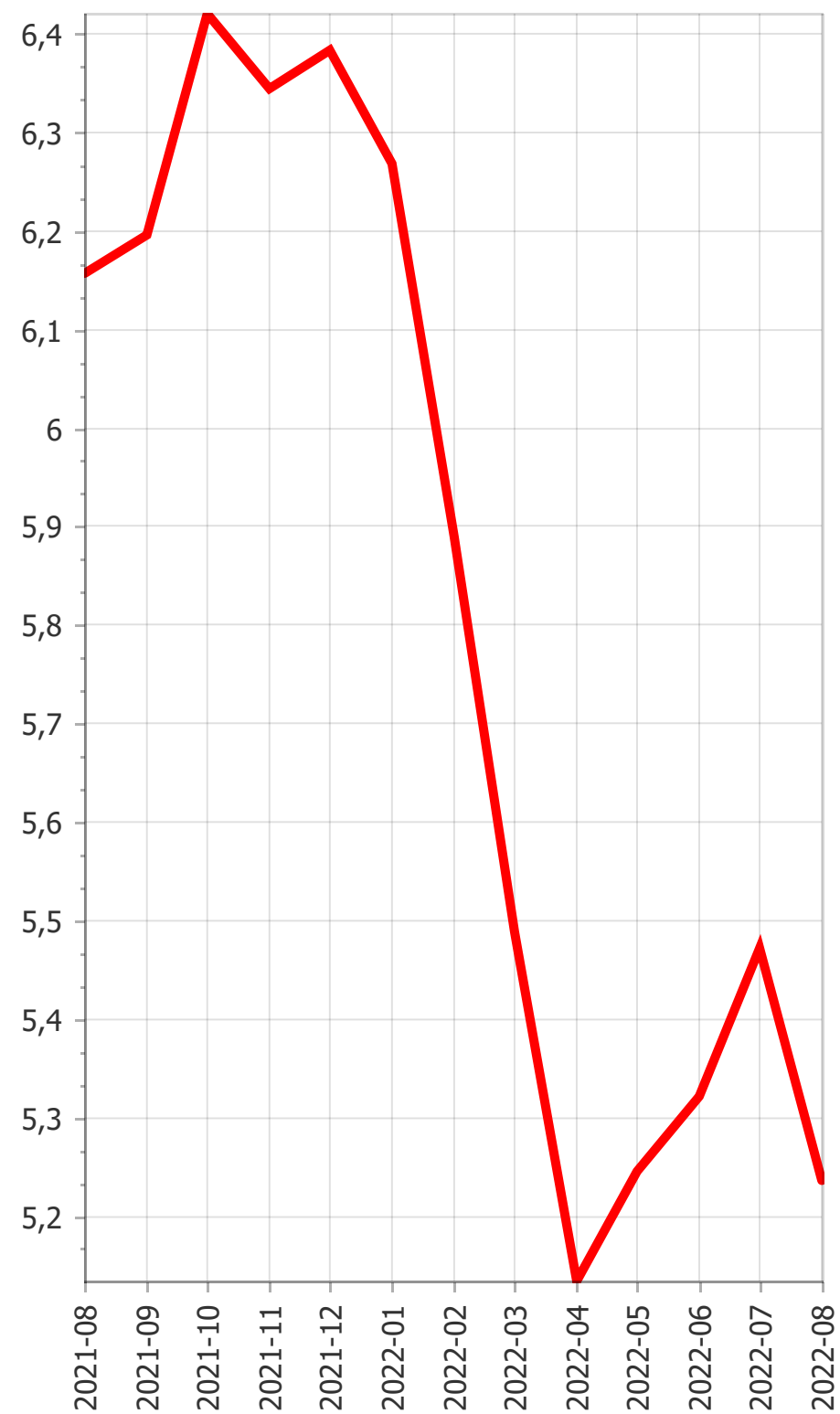

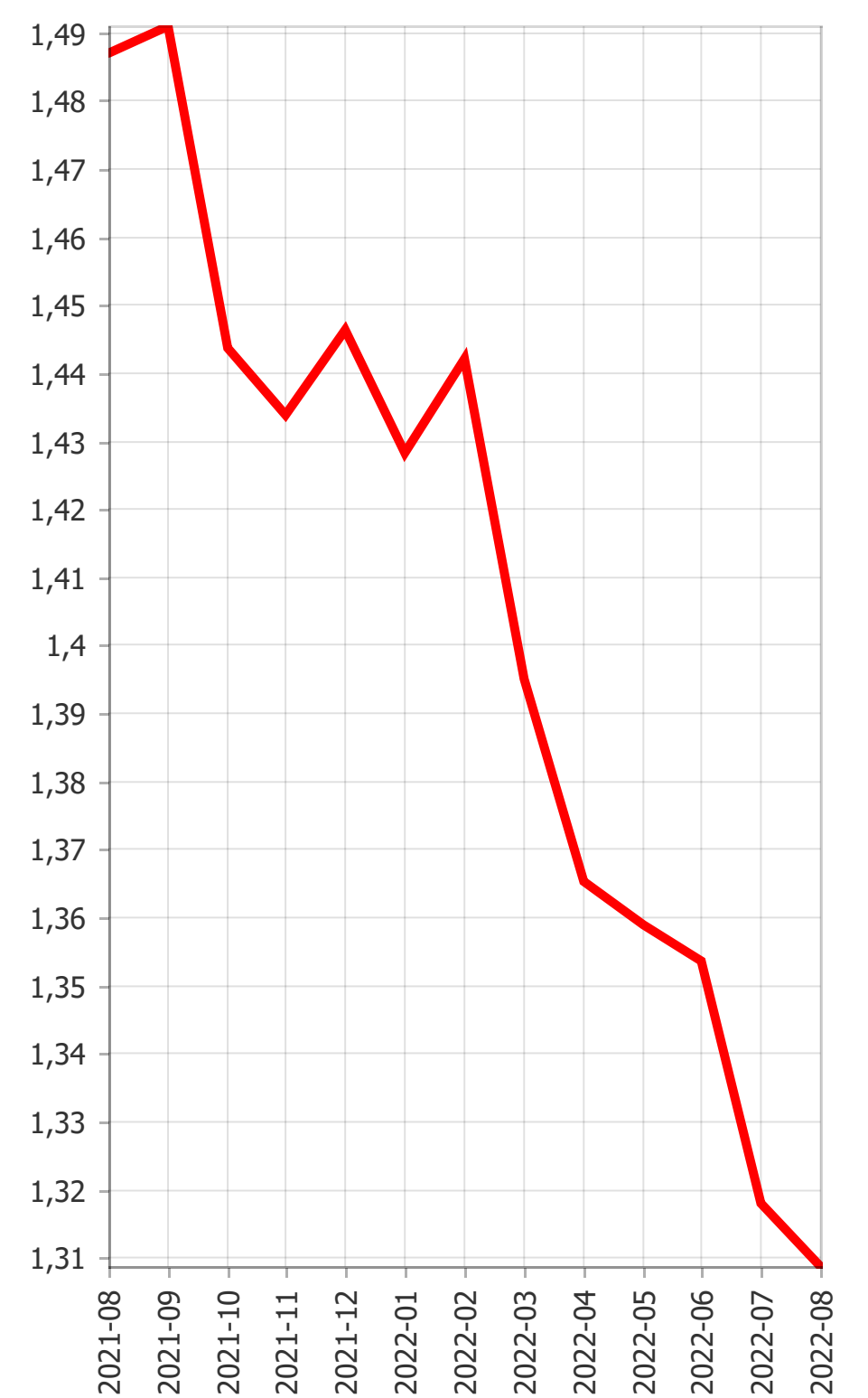

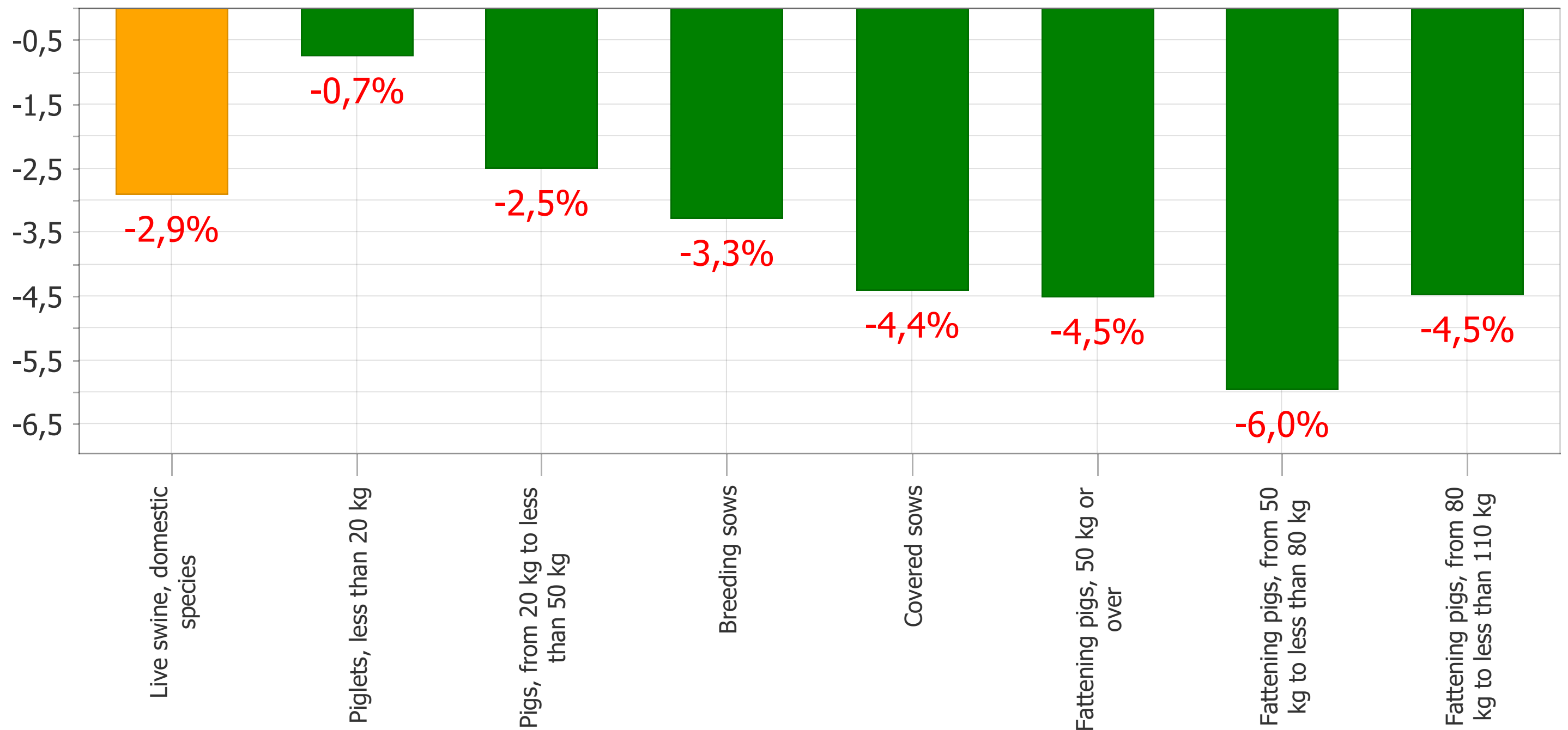

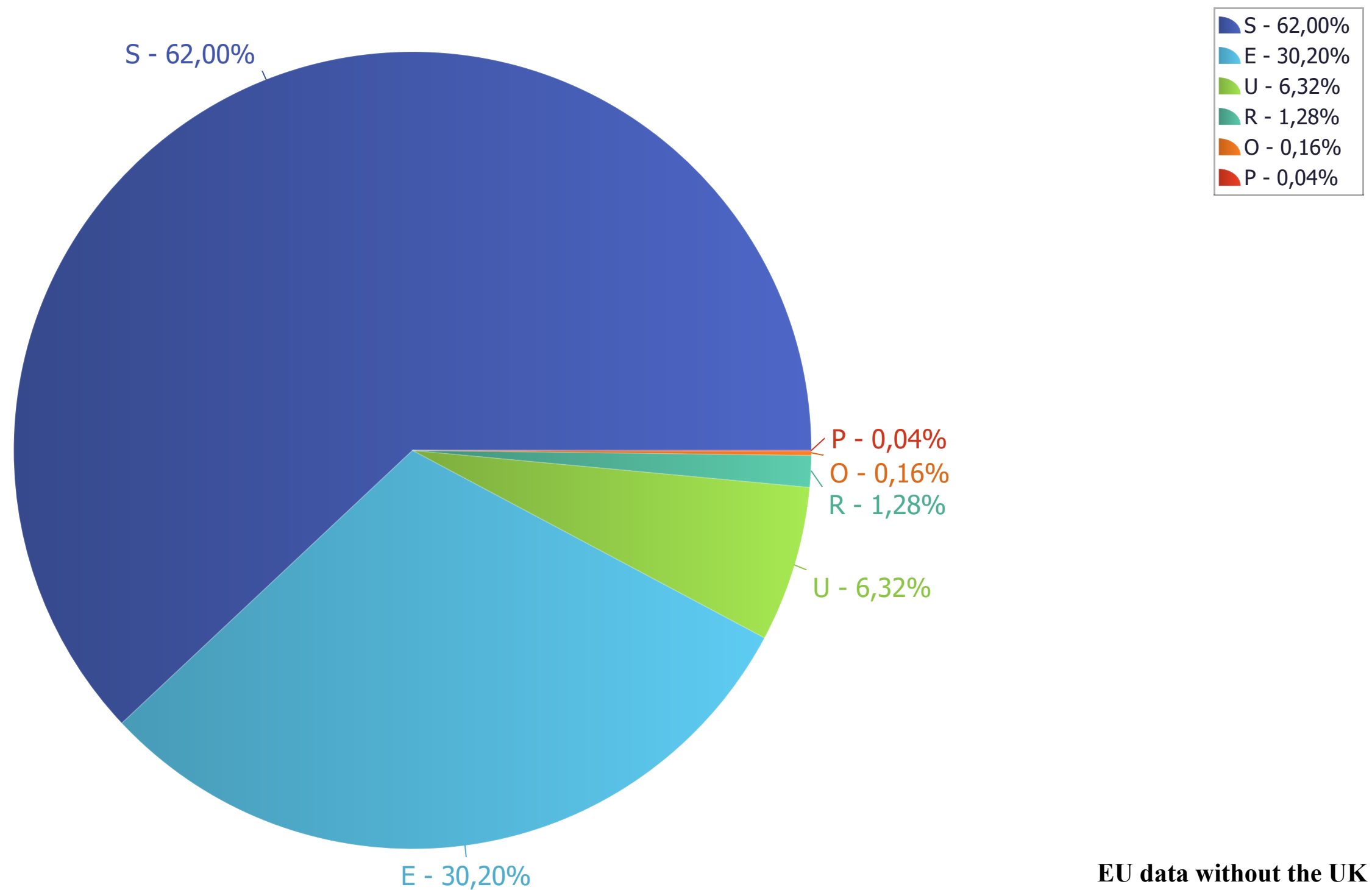
Livestock survey December 2021 compared to December 2020 (27 MS)



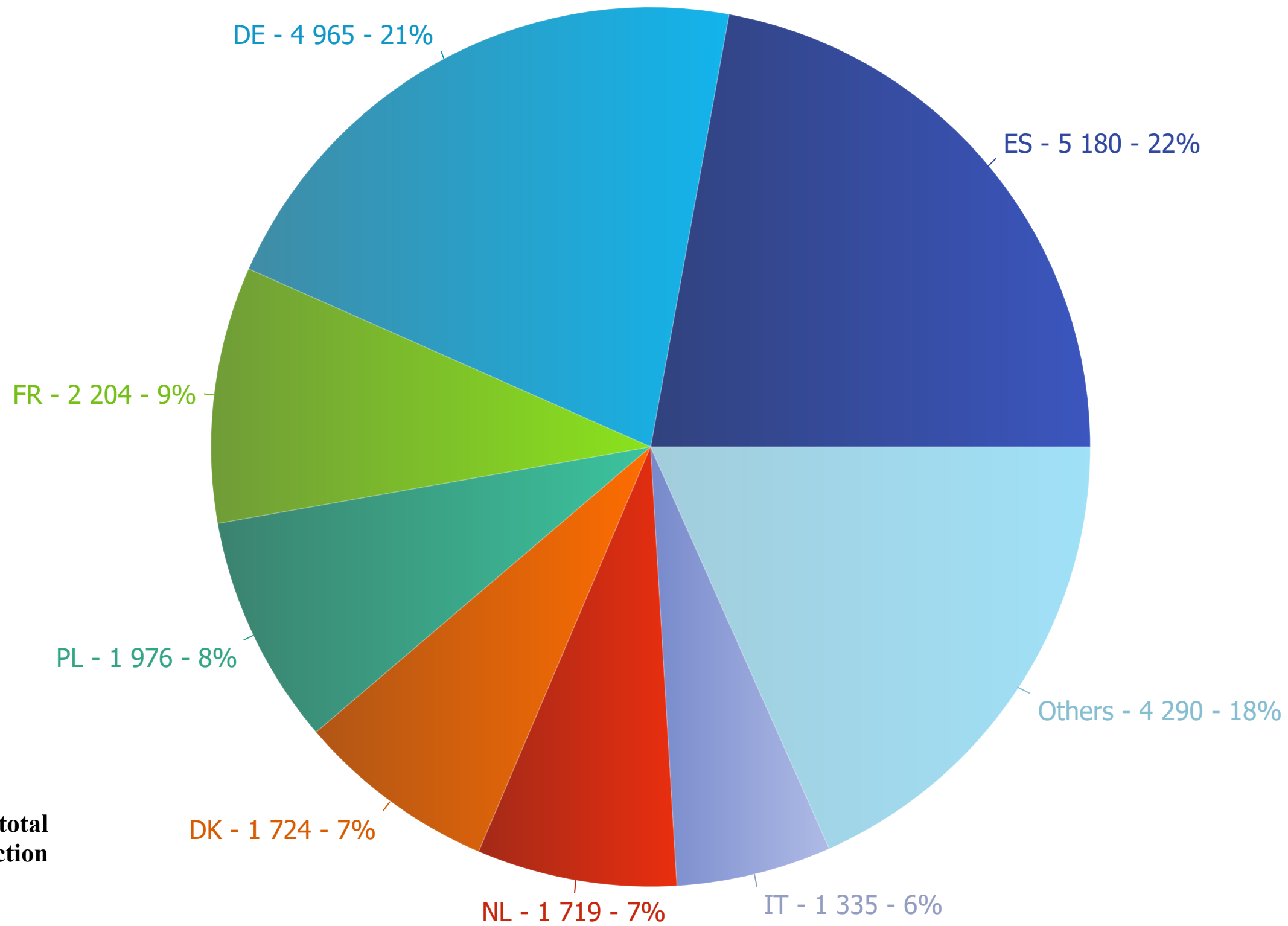

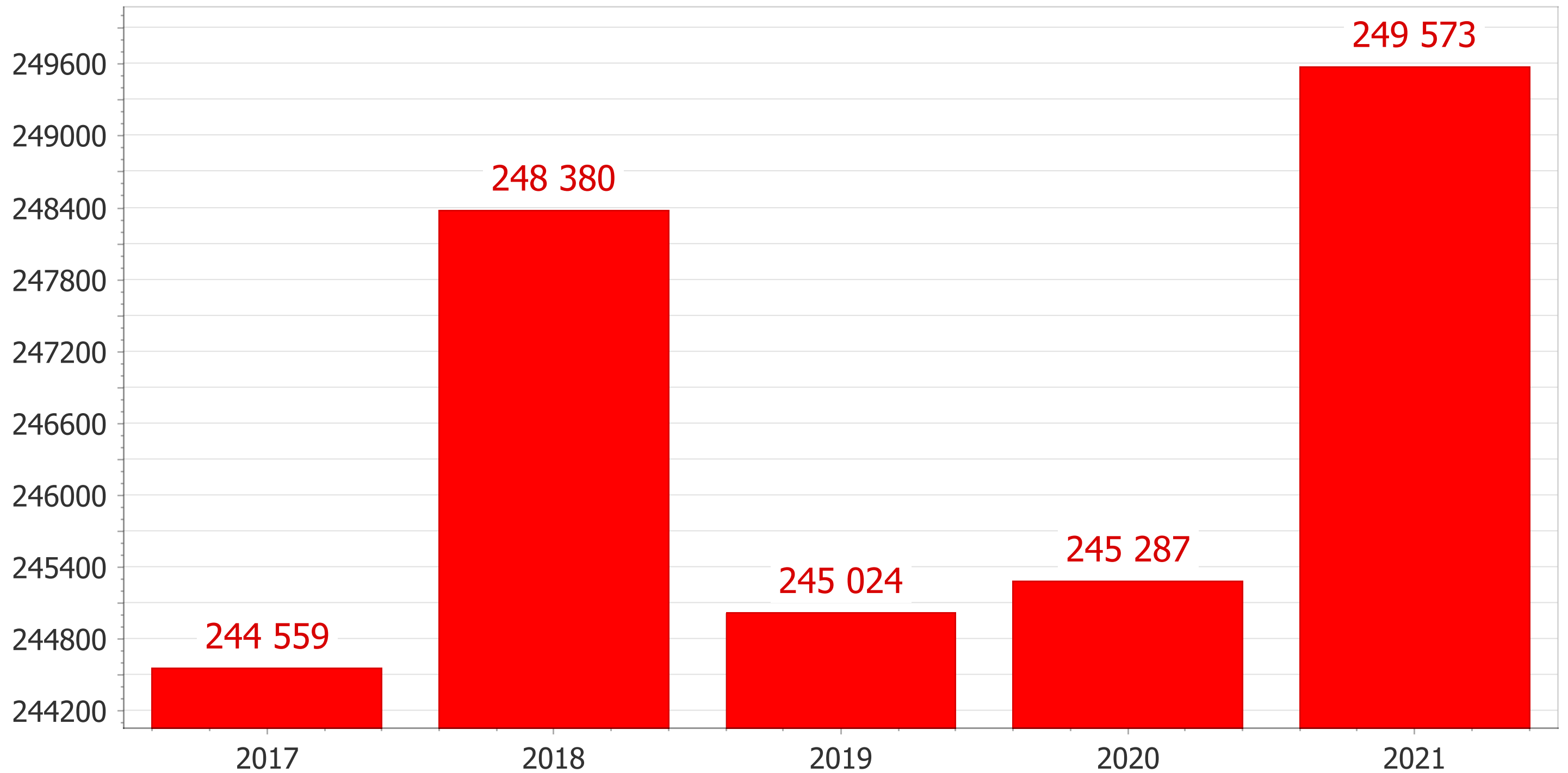

EU pig slaughter by year (in 1000 heads)



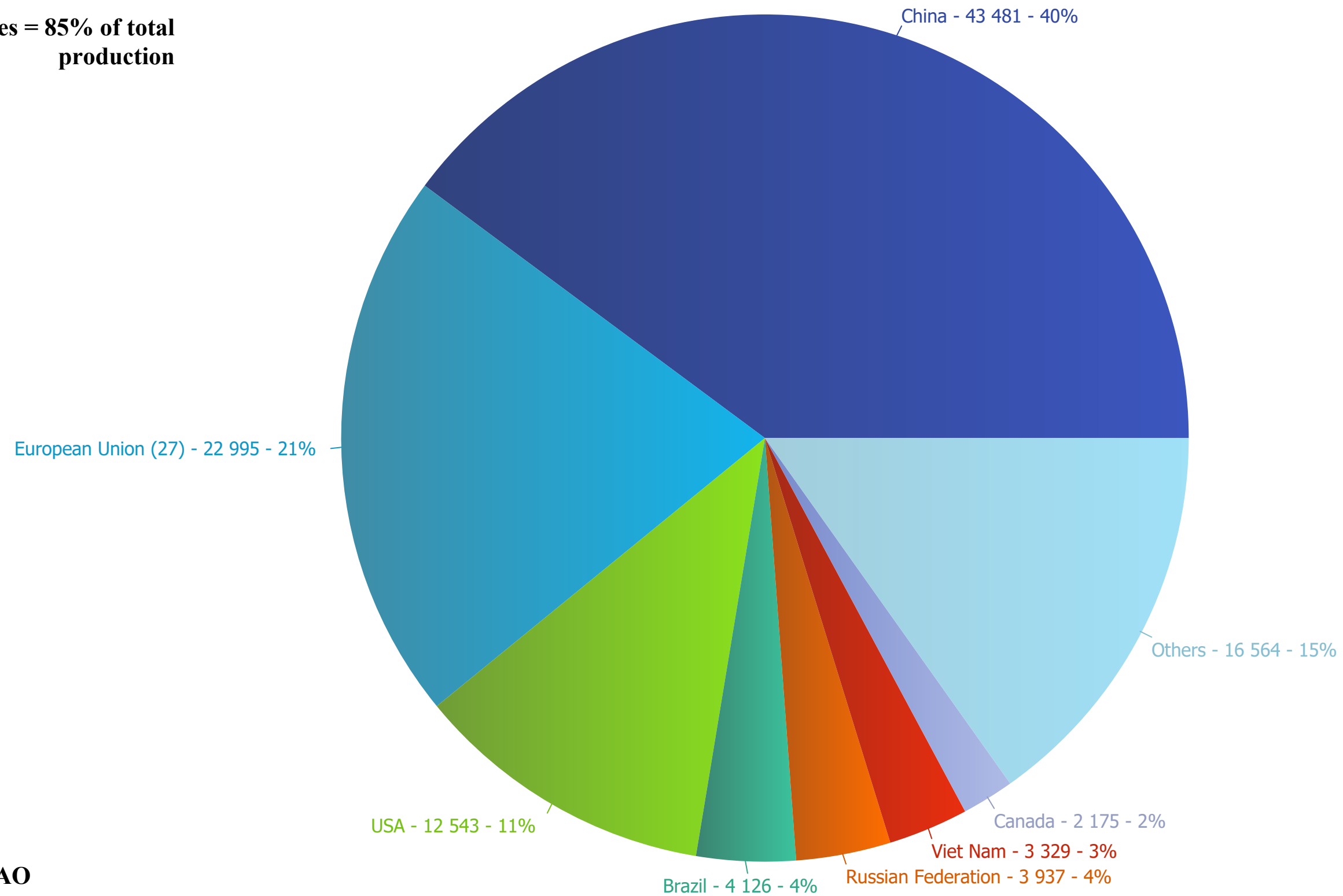

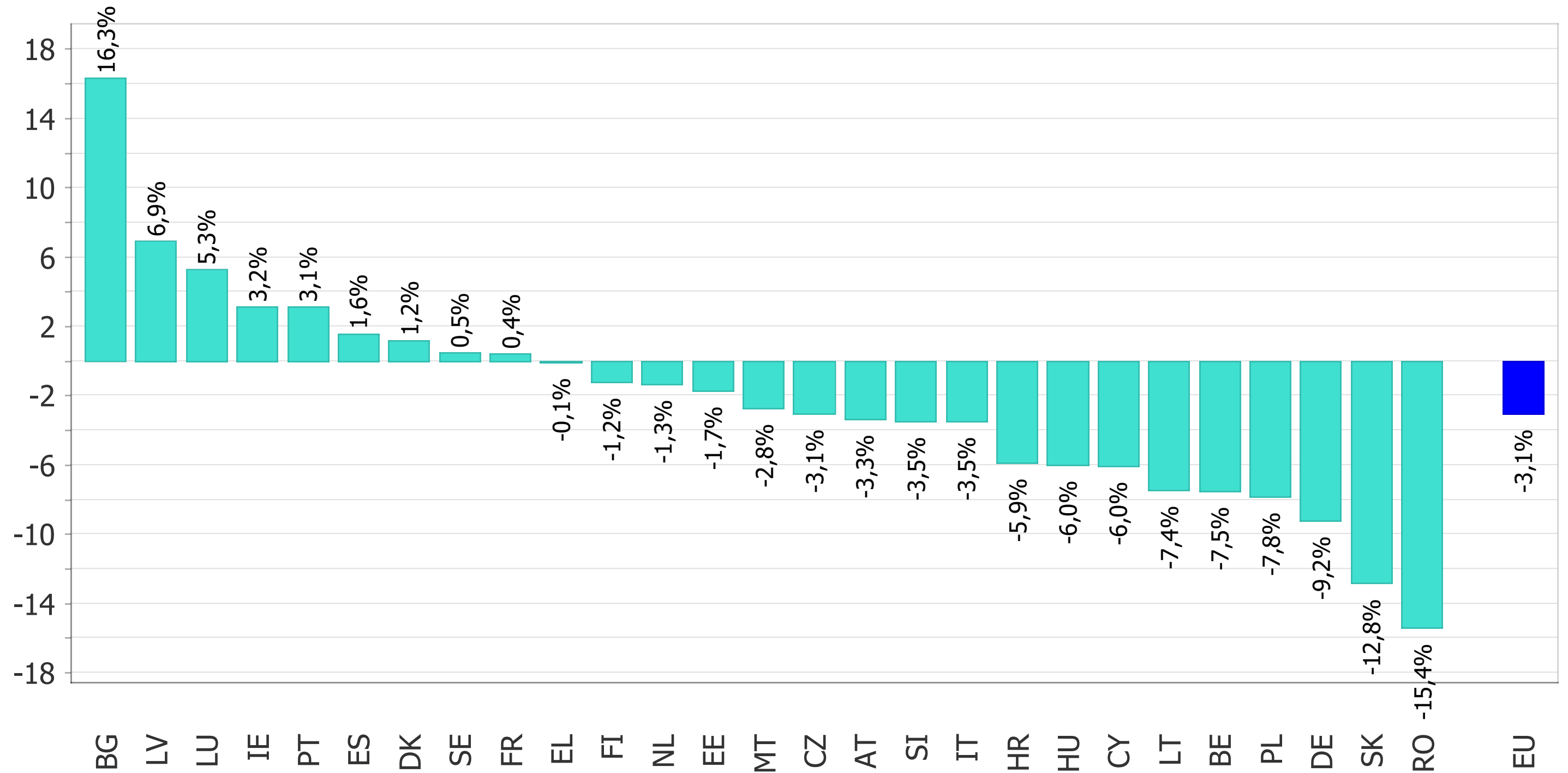

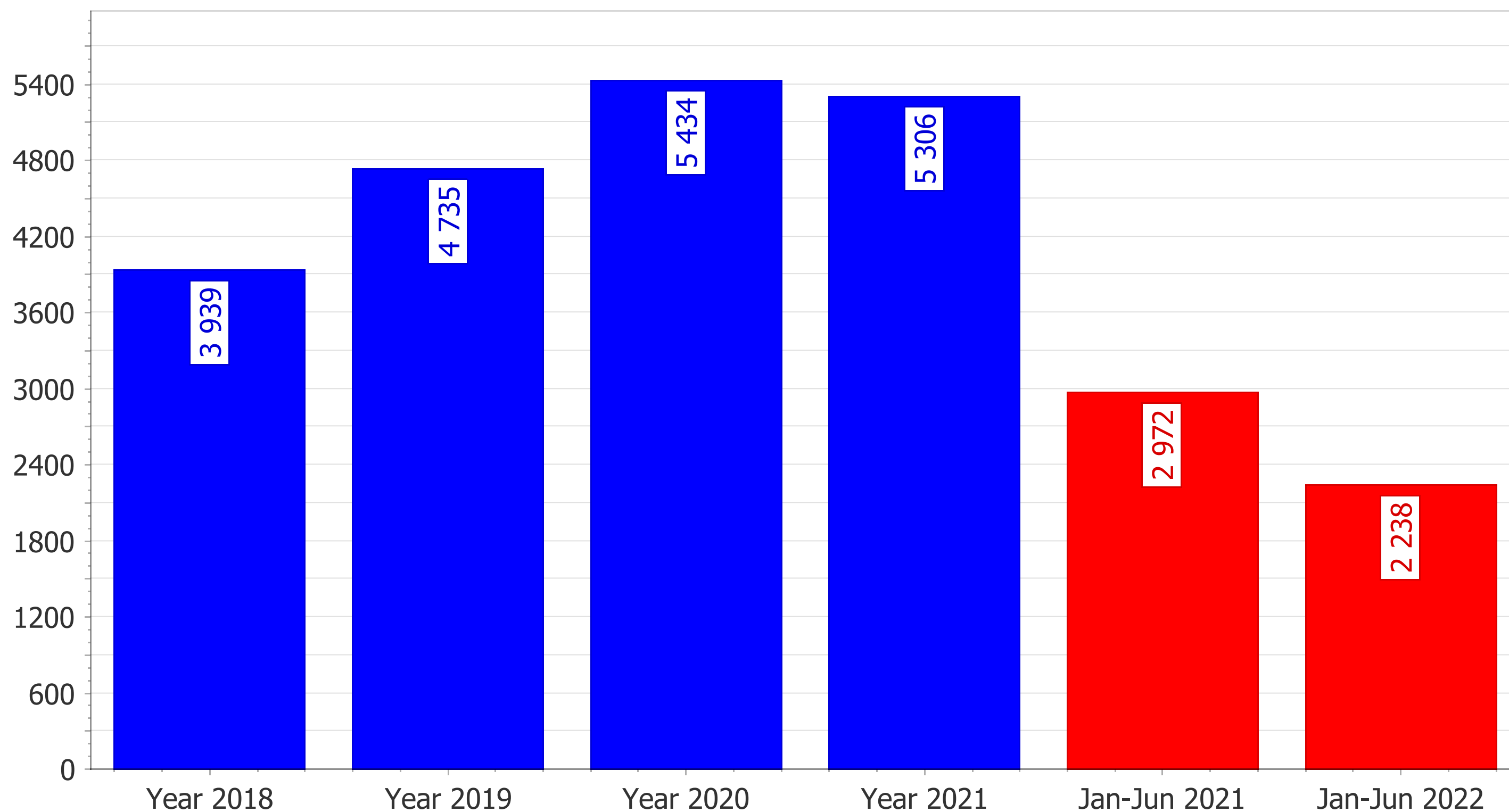

EU+UK Exports evolution (in 1000 tonnes carcase weight)



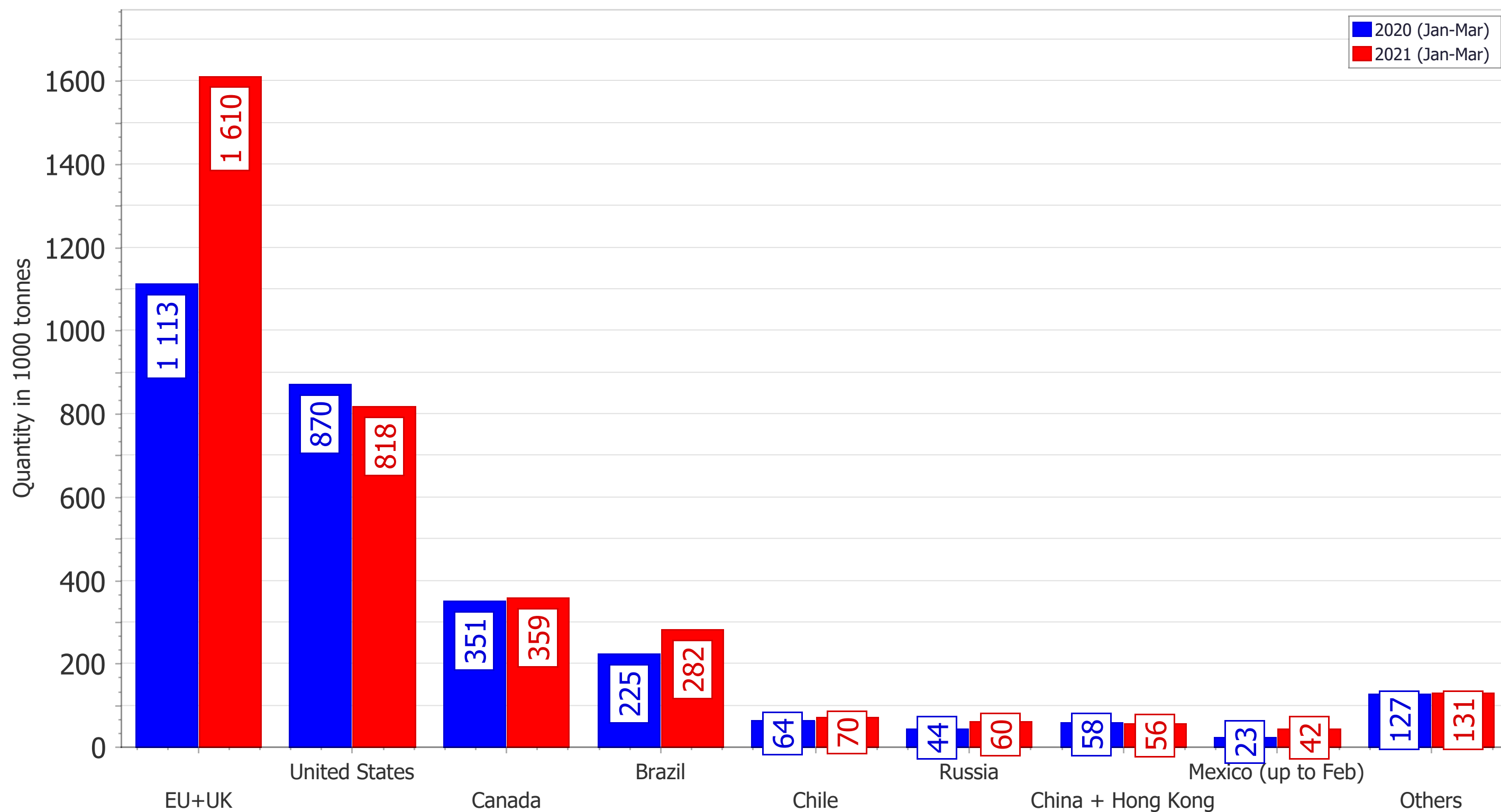

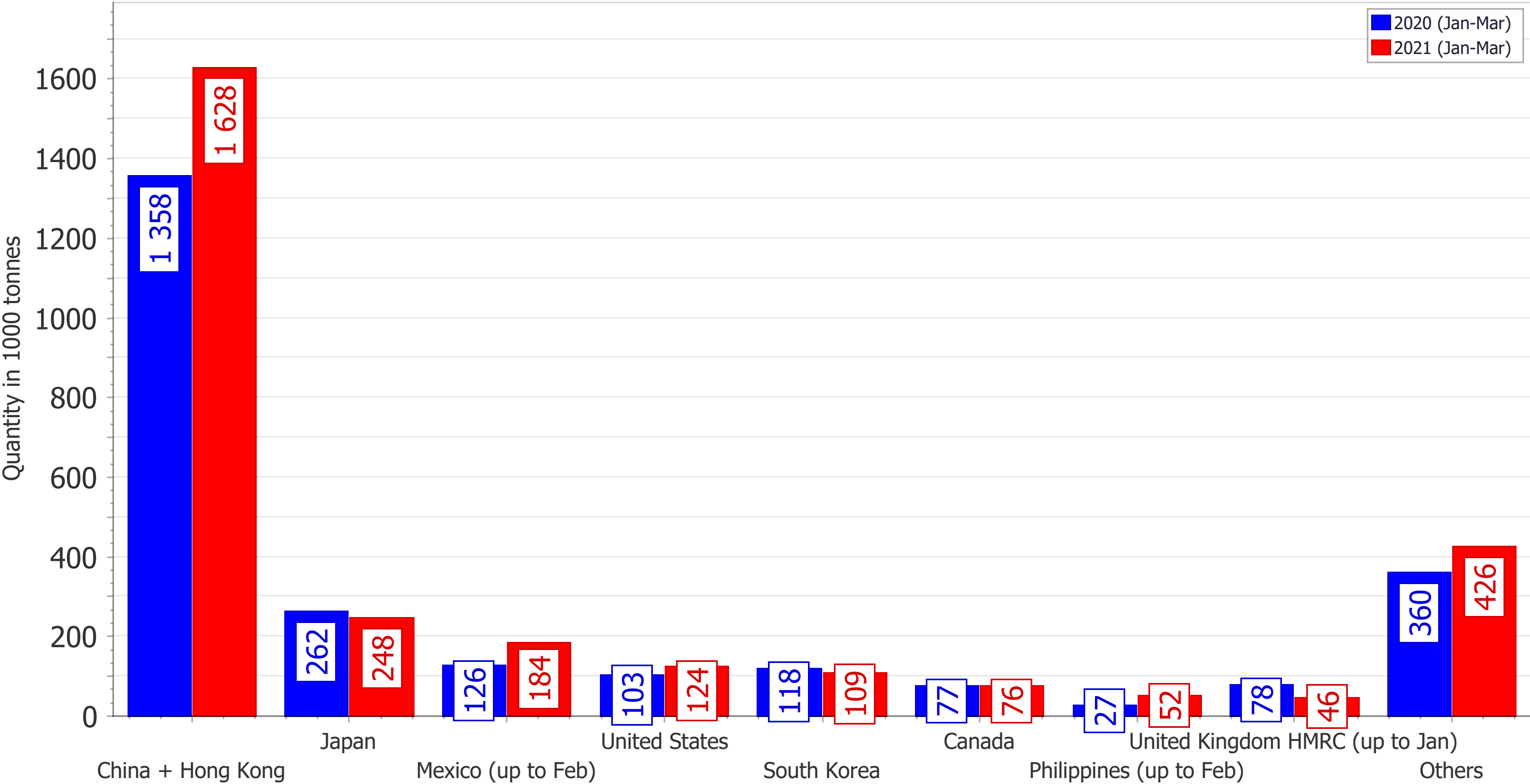
