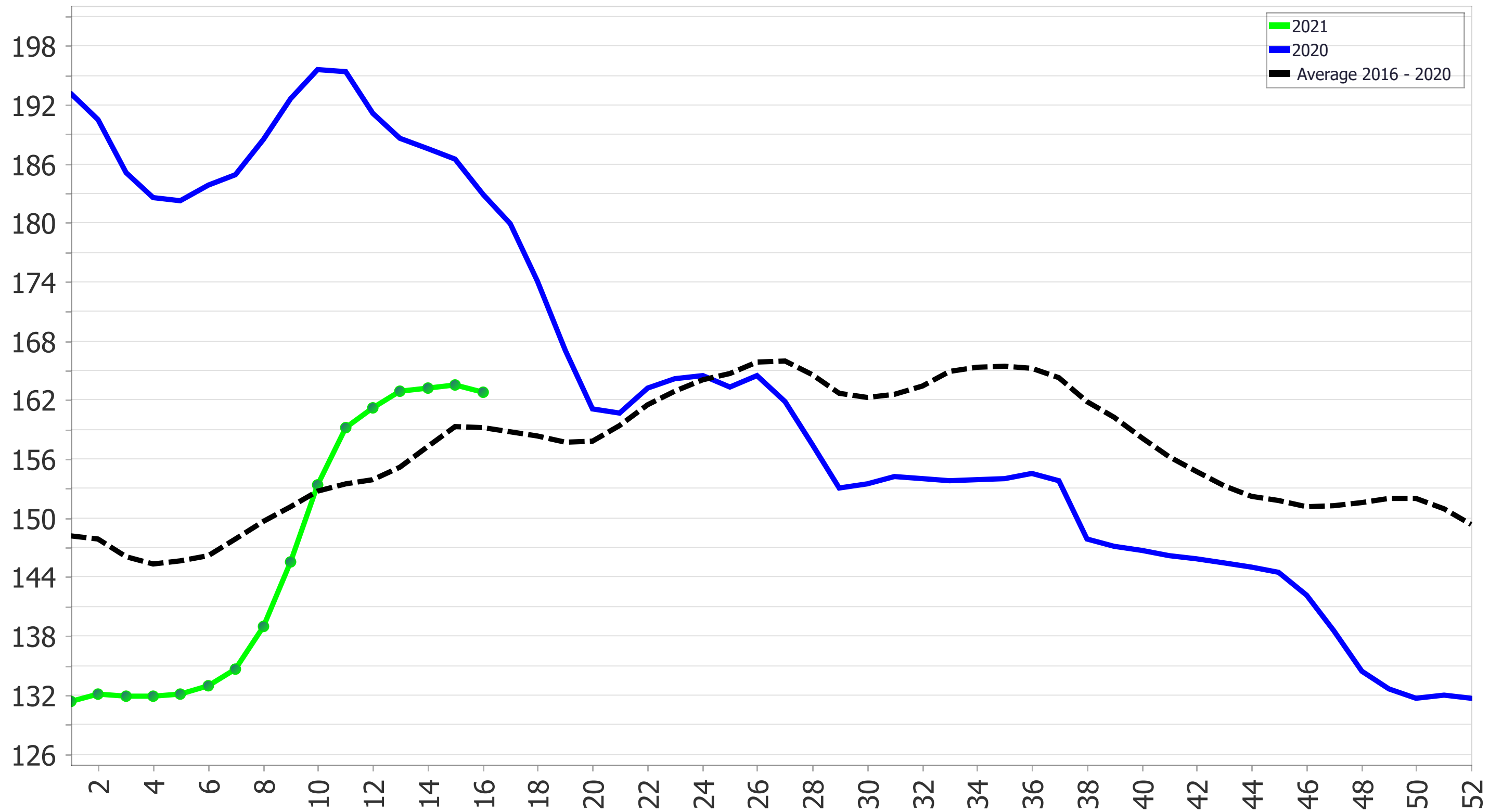

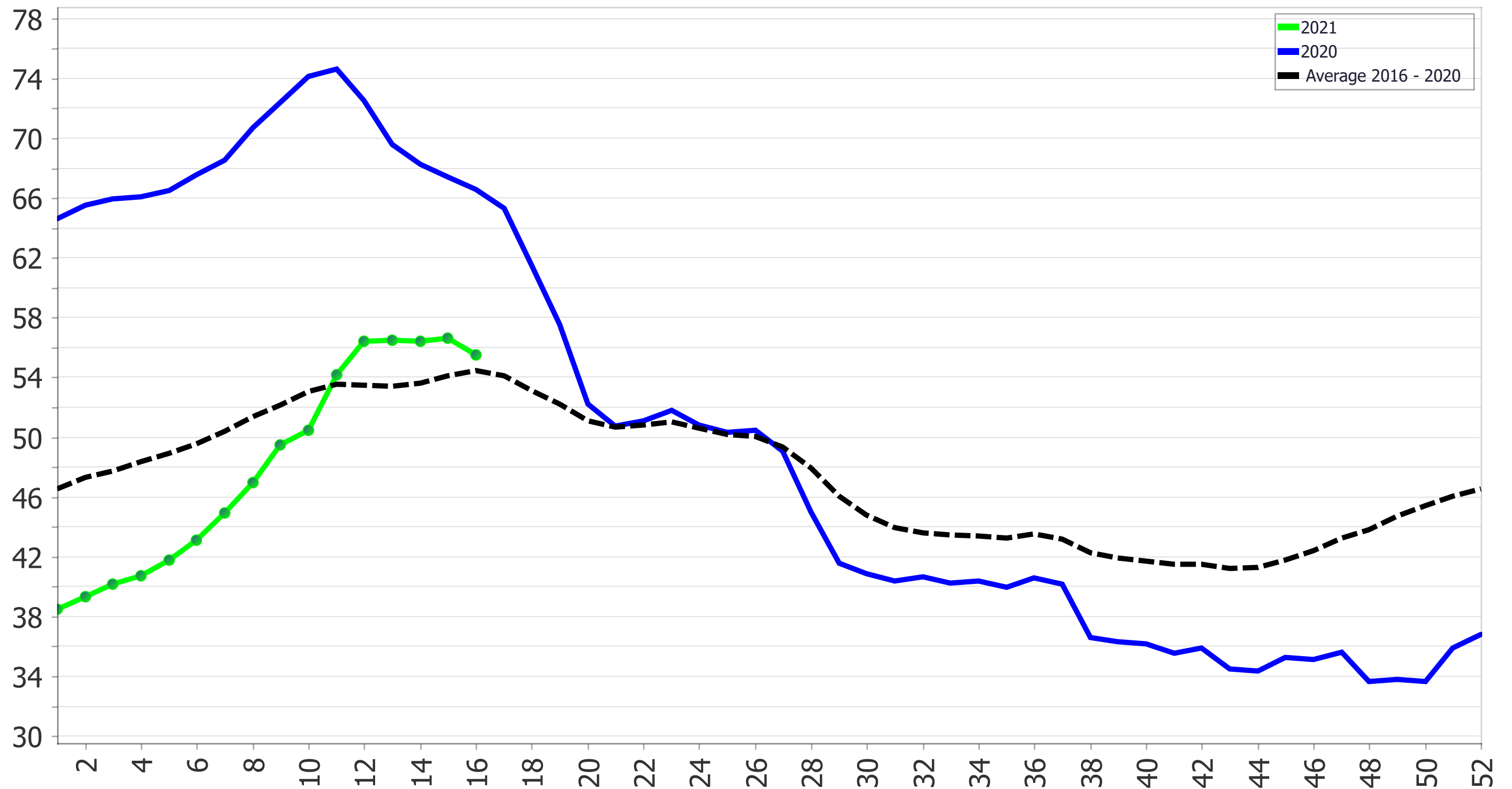
# EU evolution of the EU pig carcasse prices (€/100kg)

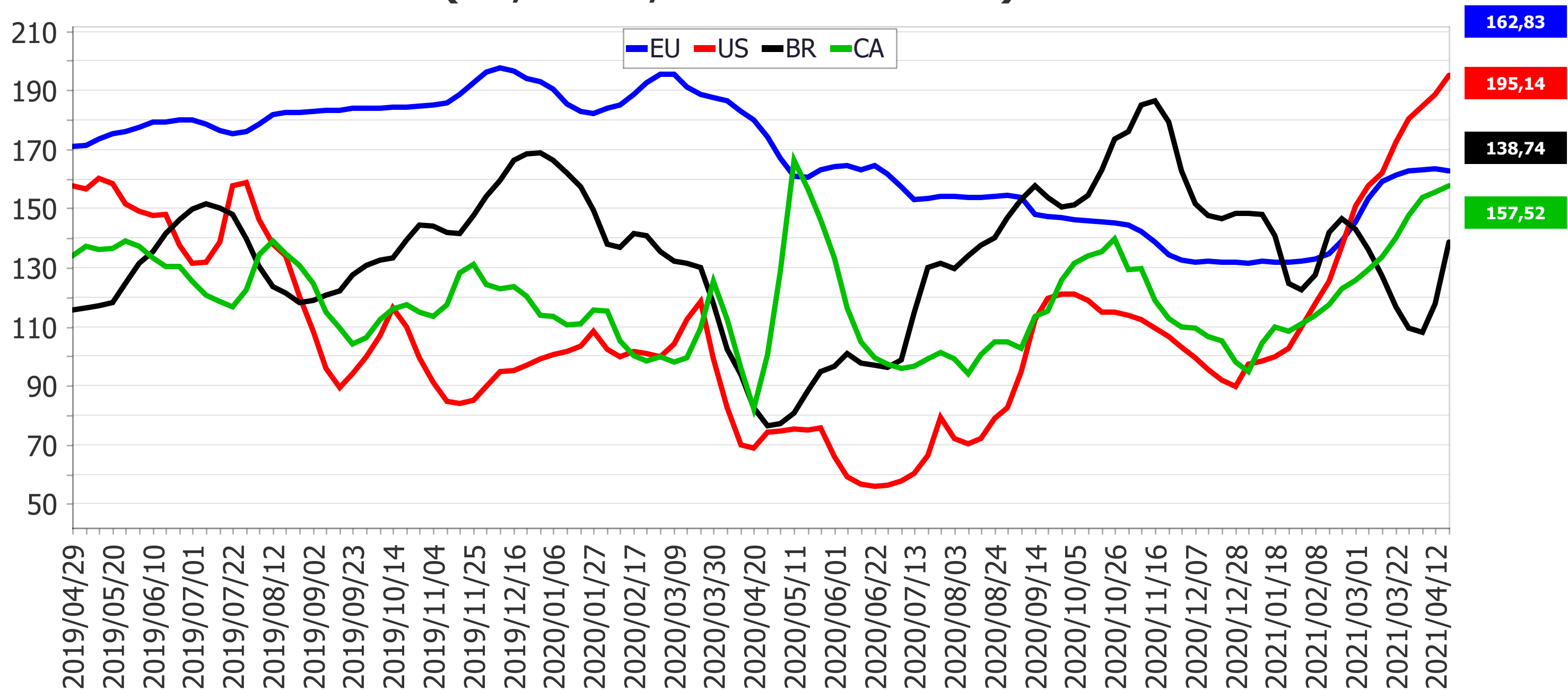
# EU evolution of the EU average piglet prices (€/head)

# World weekly average Pig Prices 2019-2021 in Euro / 100Kg carcase (EU, Brazil, Canada and USA)



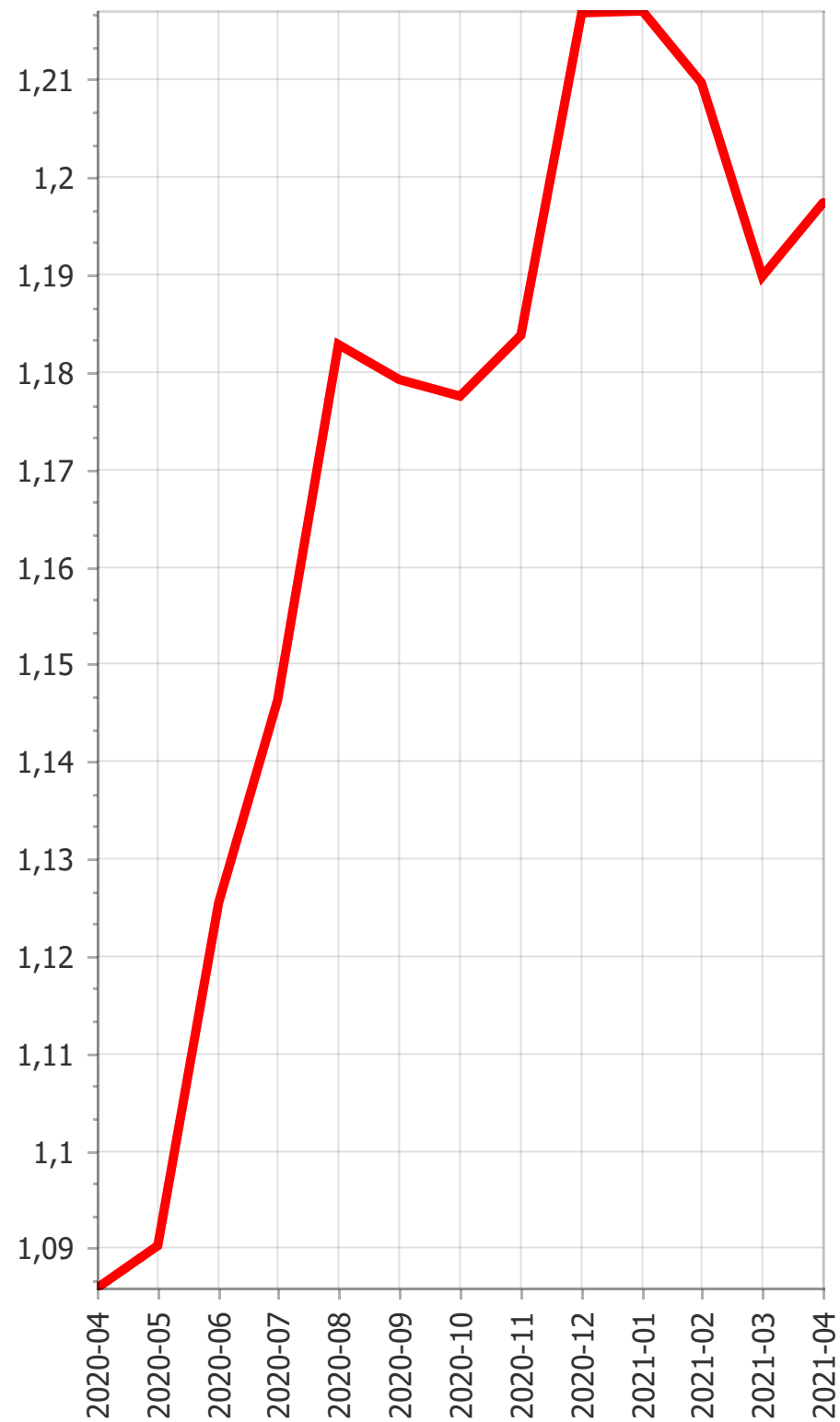

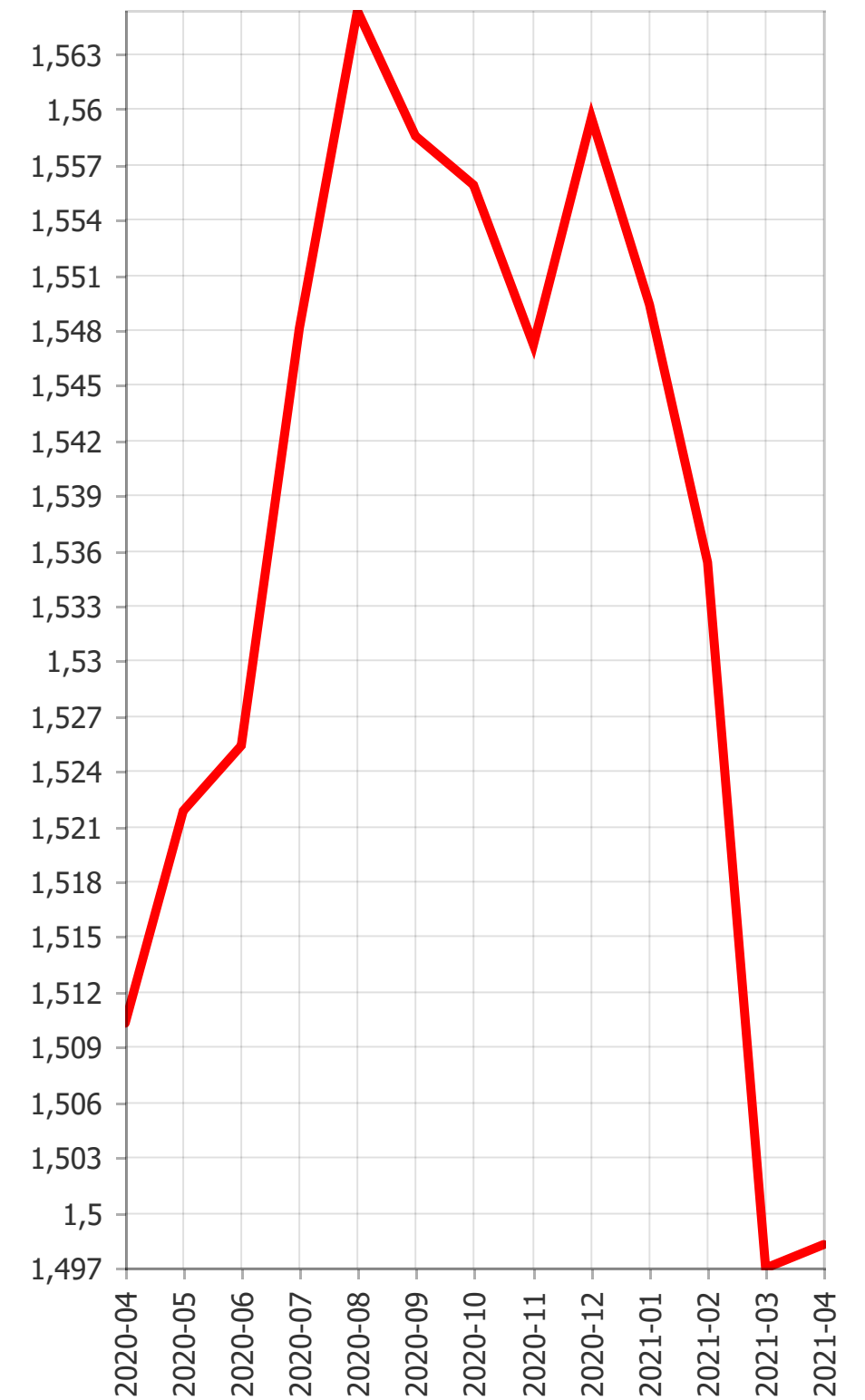

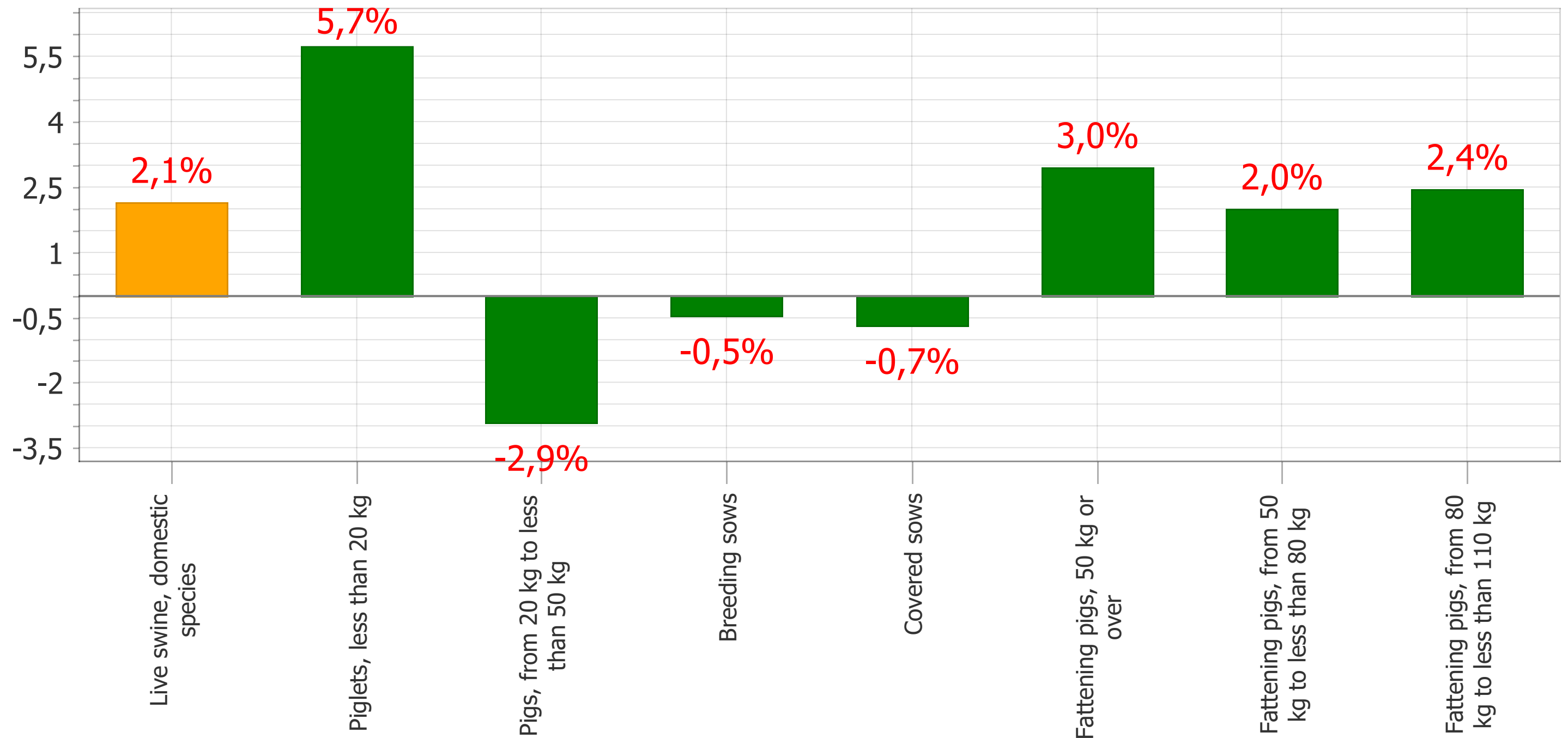

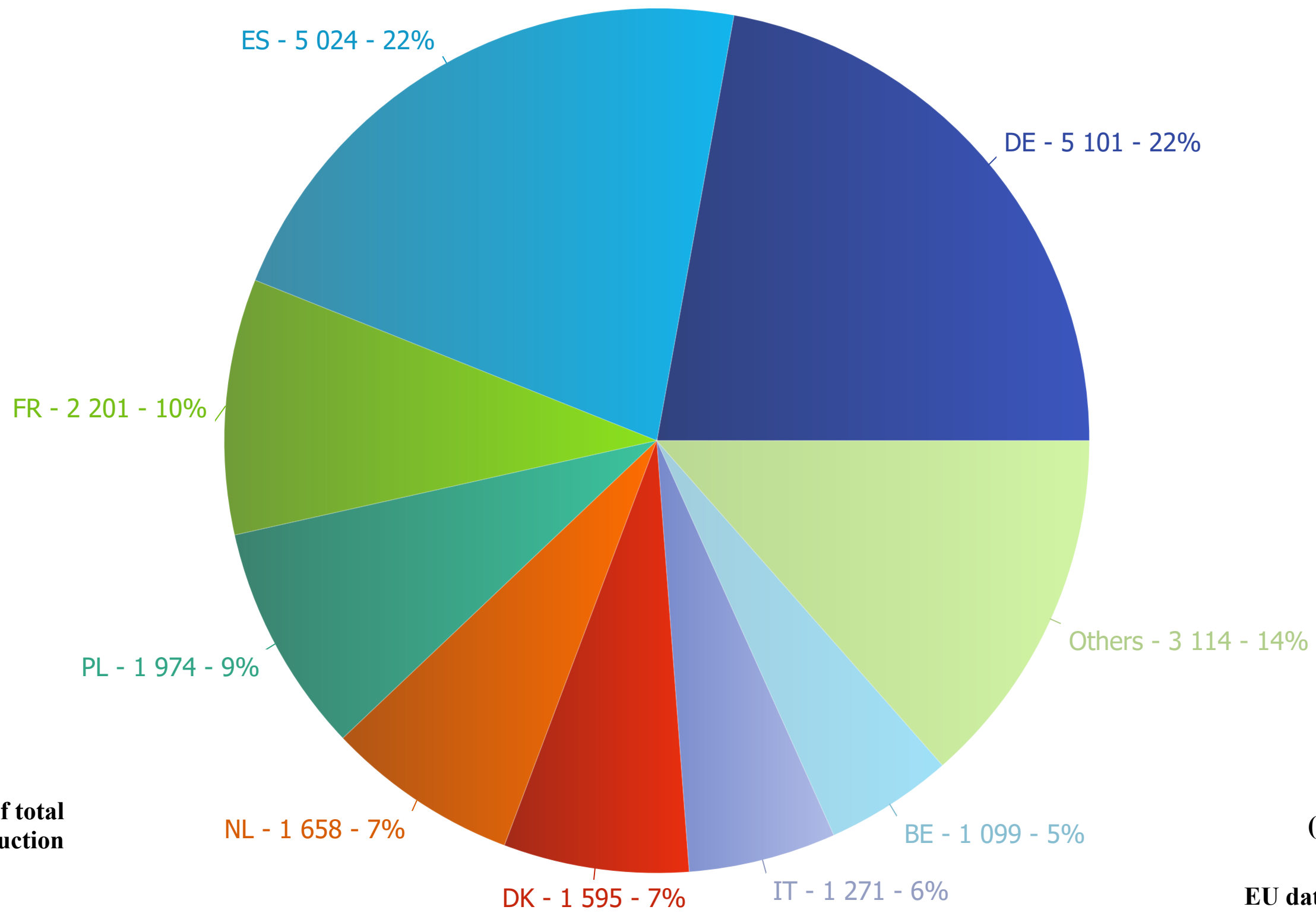
## Distribution of pig carcasses on grades (EU average 2019)



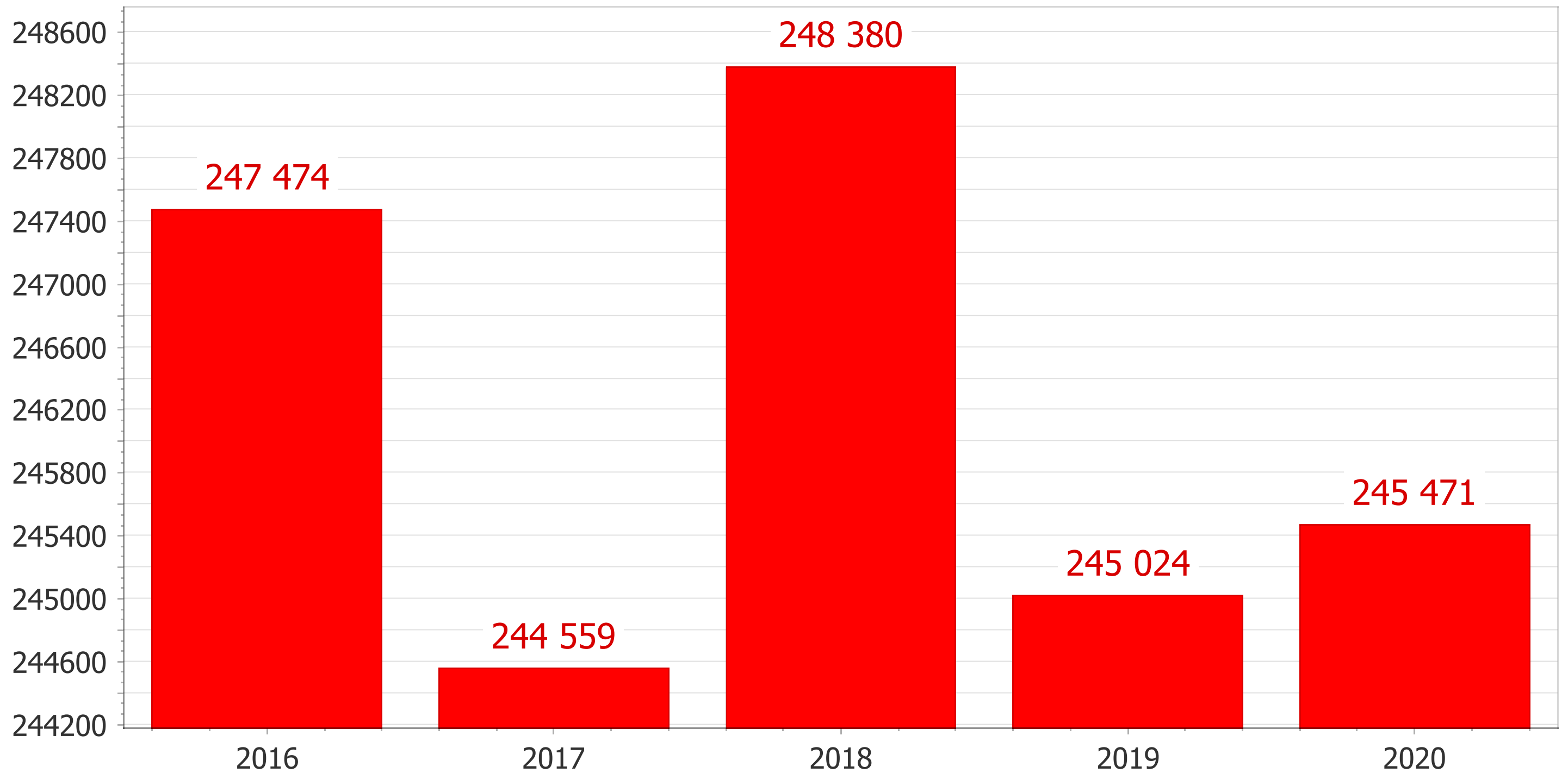

## EU pig slaughter by year (in 1000 heads)



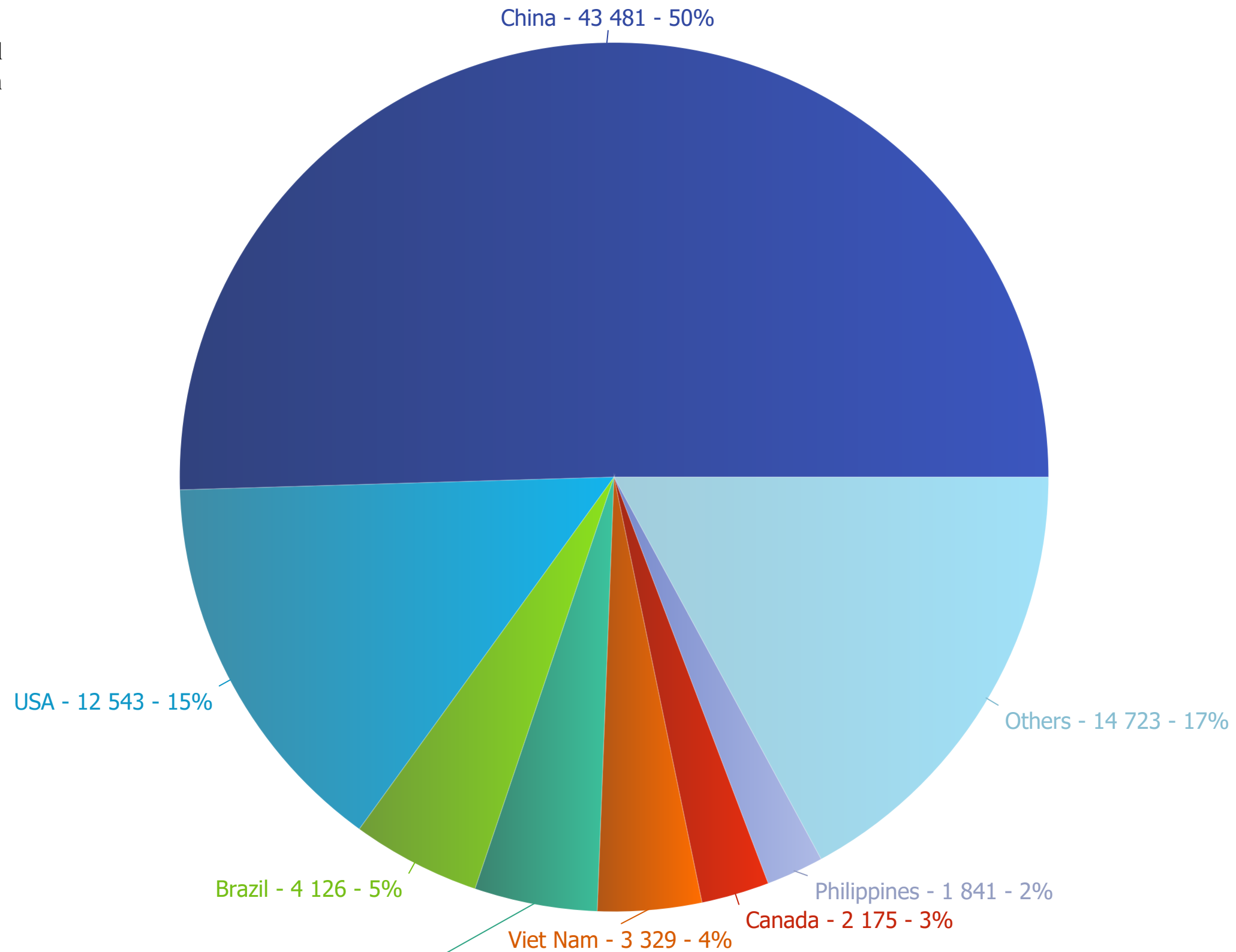

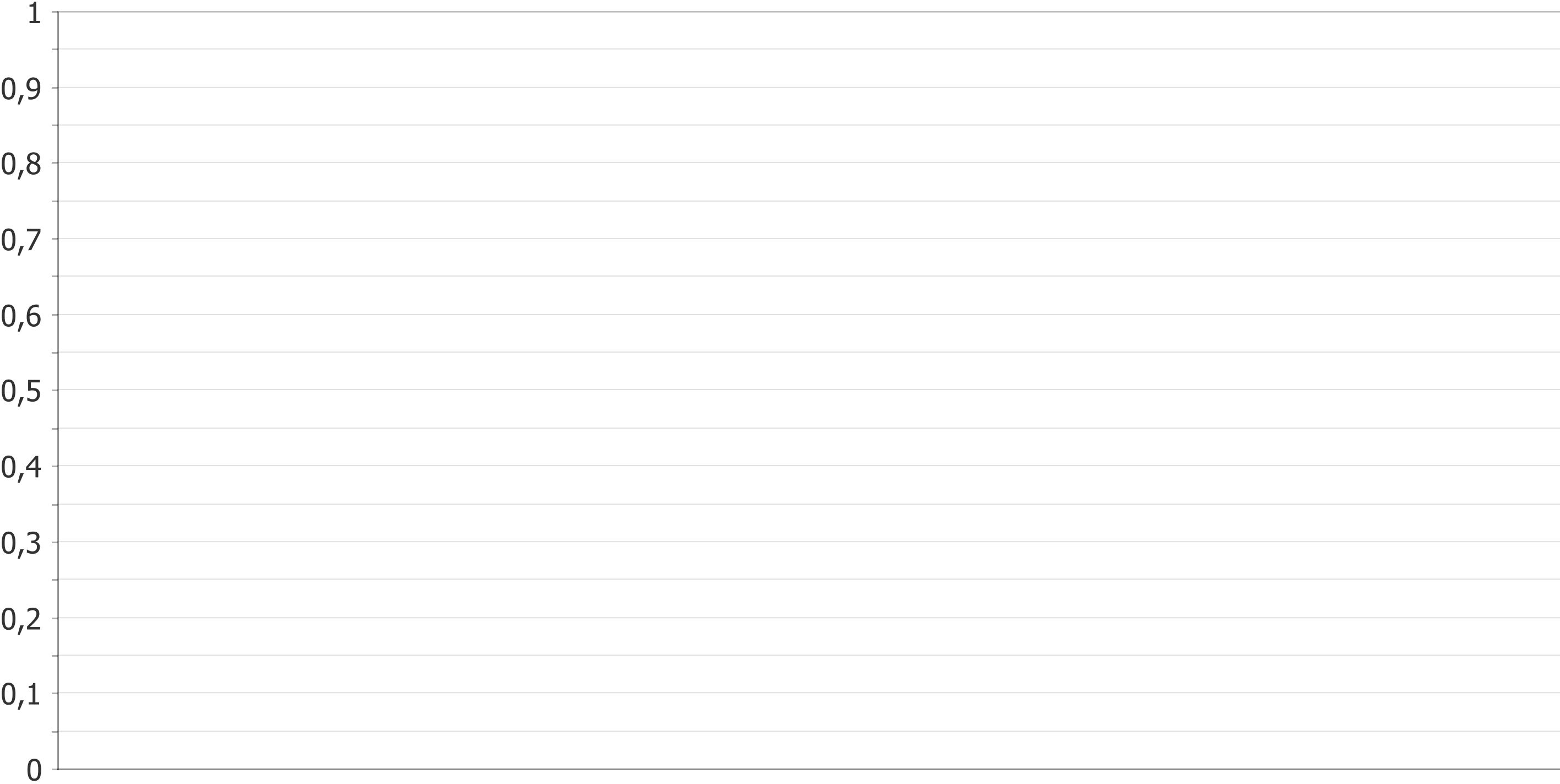

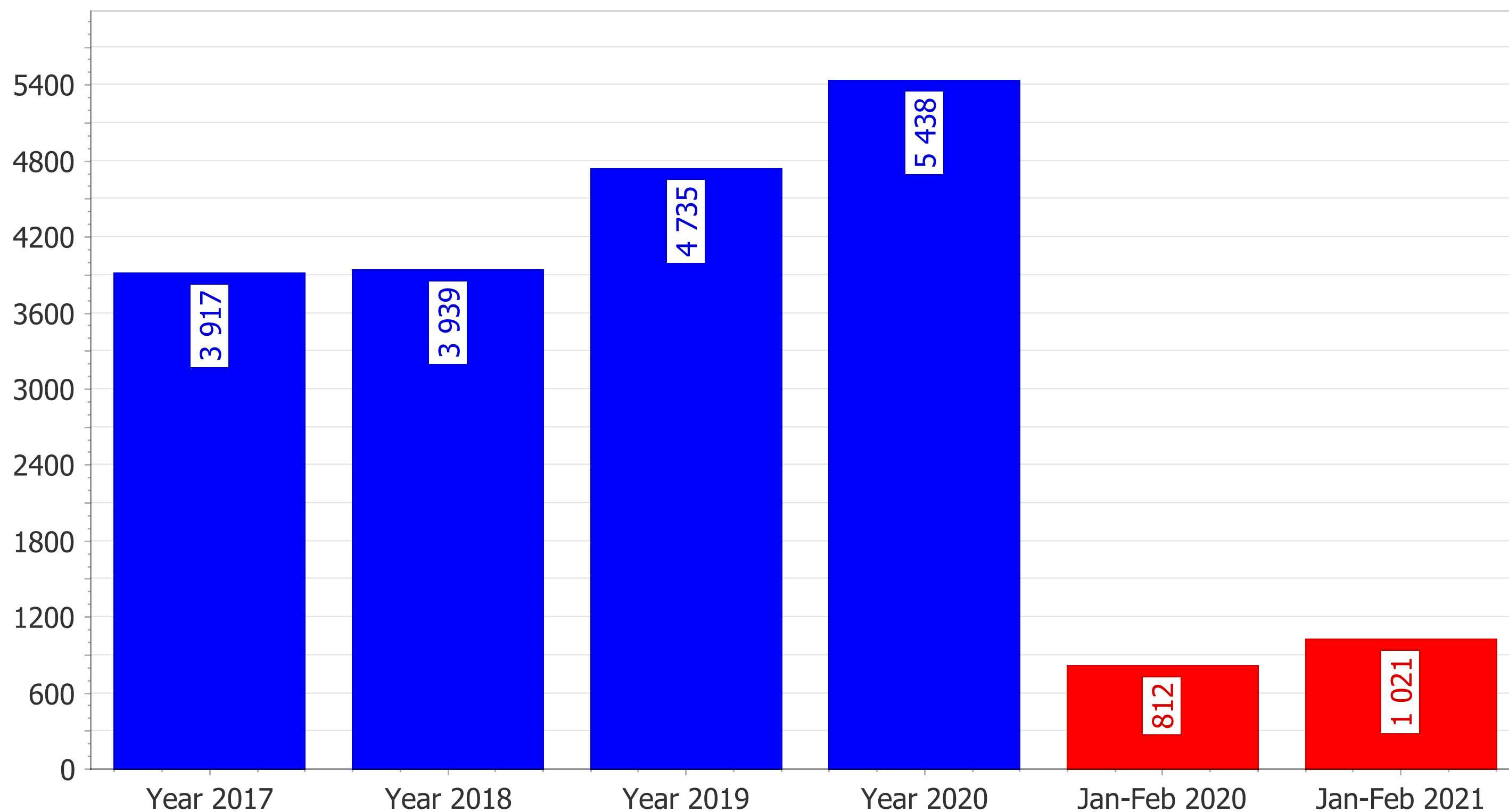

## EU+UK Exports evolution (in 1000 tonnes carcase weight)



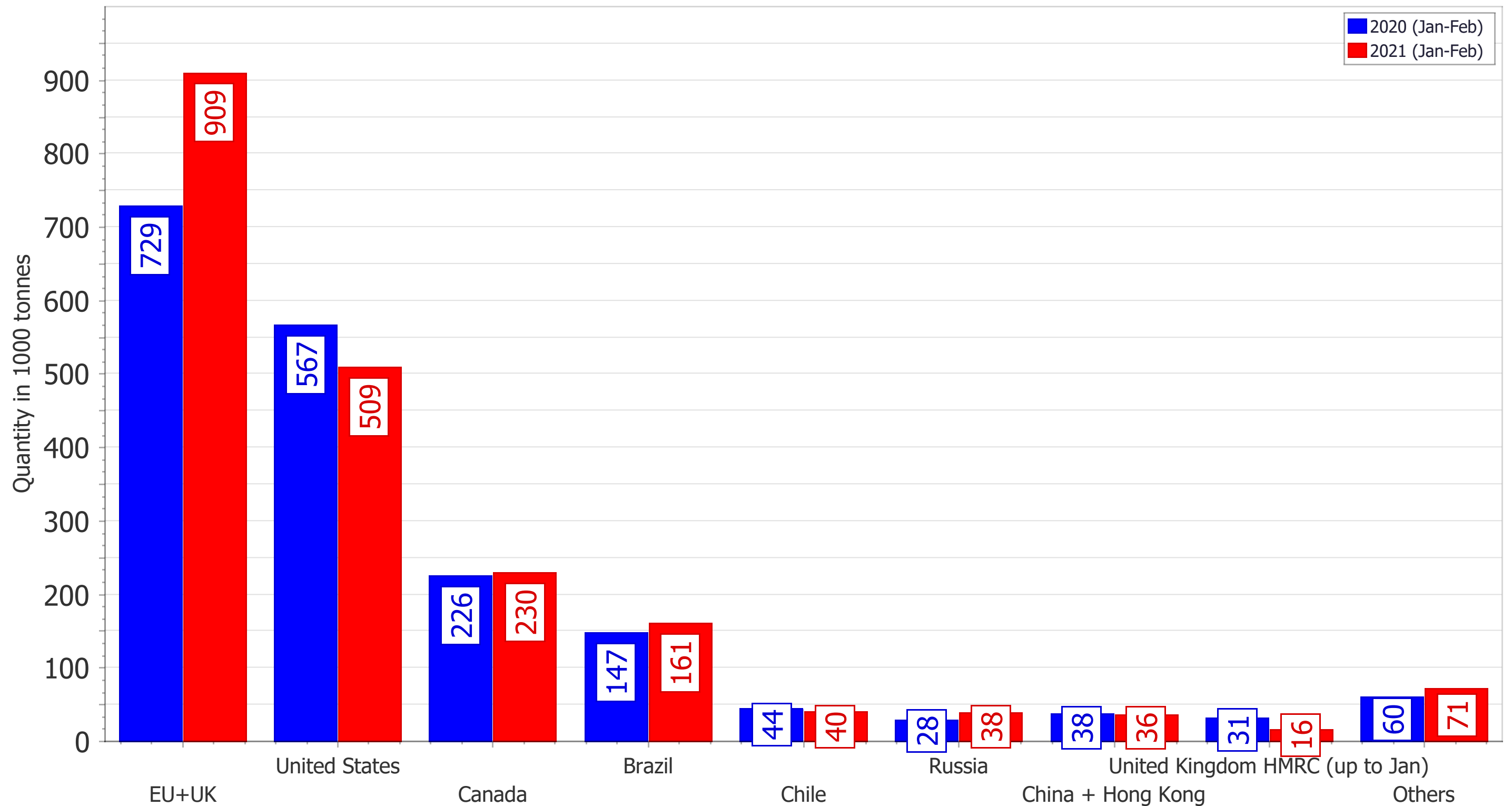

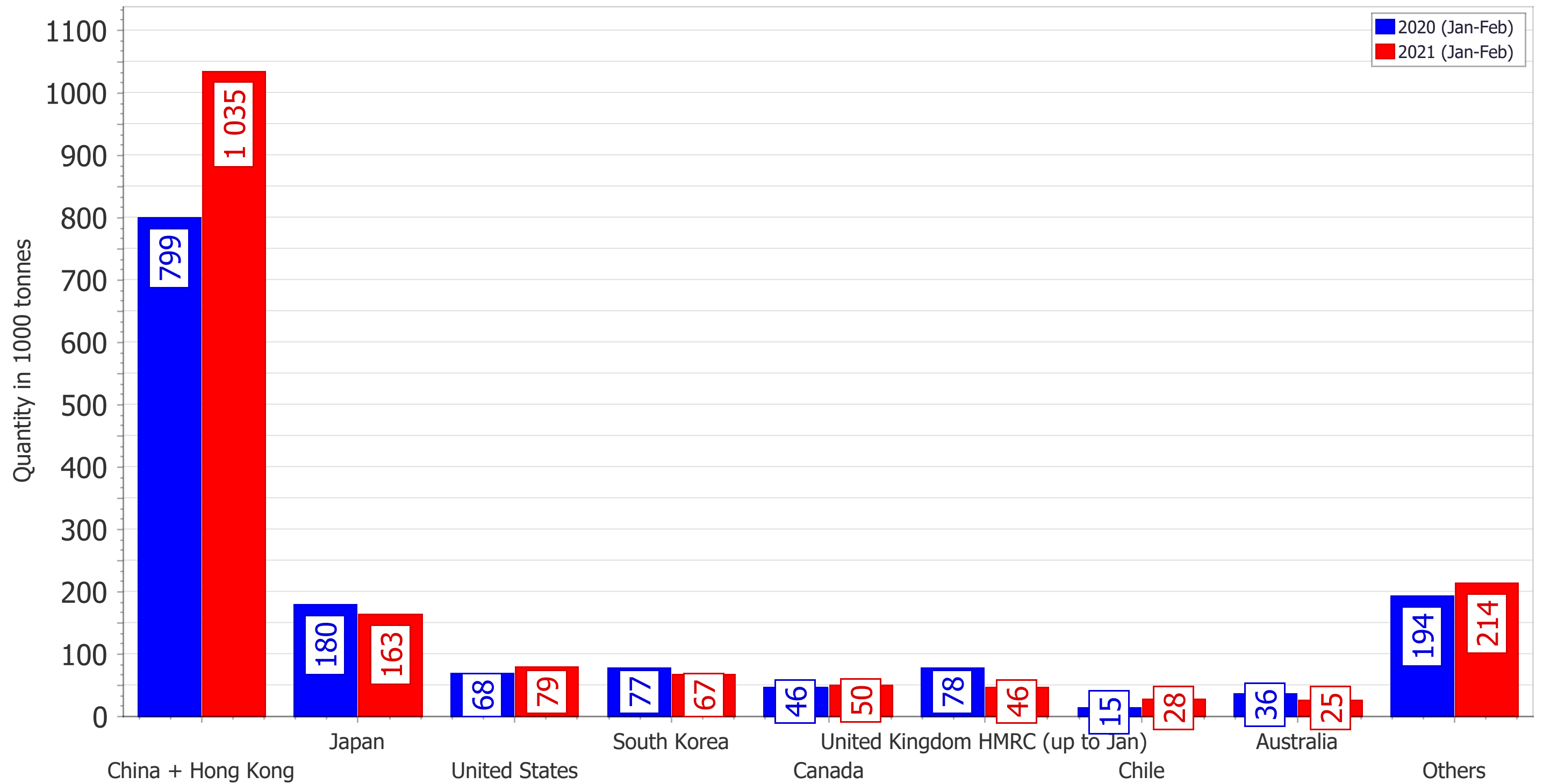
